How can we help at home?	<p>Listen to your child sing or play on the instrument on which they will perform their recital</p> <p>Encourage your child to practice for half an hour each day on their instrument/voice. The performance part of the course is 40% of the grade. Students will need encouragement to complete their homework for this part of the course which is to practice!</p> <p>Encourage your child to listen to a wide range of different styles of music; recorded and live.
