

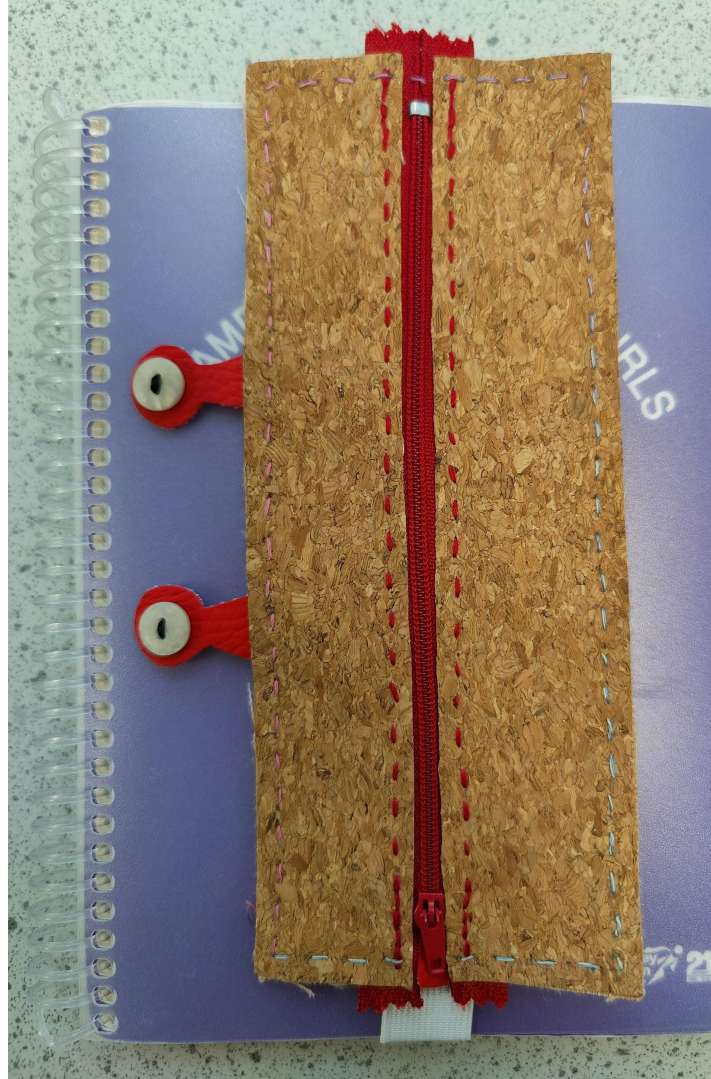
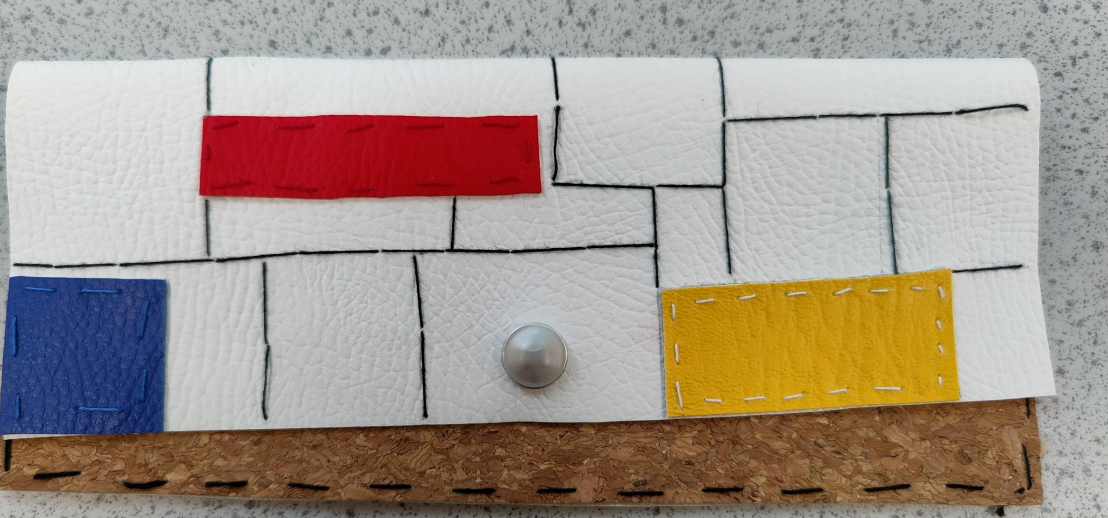
# Year 8 Smart Planner Pencil Cases

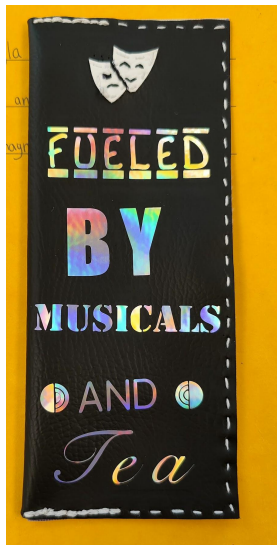






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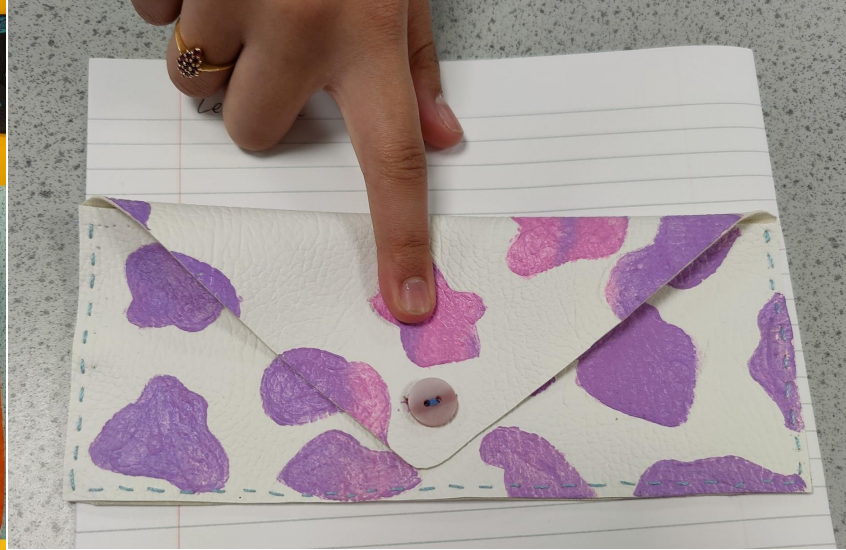
















## Making A Pencil Case - Step by Step

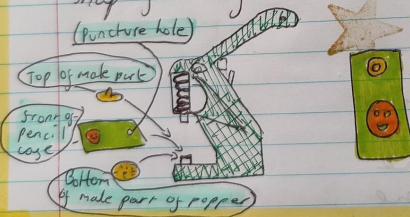
- 1 - Create a paper template that shows the main shape of the pencil case (shape of flap/pocket)  
 - Create template of applique design, measured to fit  
 - Cut out applique & background in PU



- 2 Neatly sew/iron the applique on the front



- 3 Attach the 'male' part of the closing popper / snap fastening on the rivet machine (puncture hole)



- 4 Quality Control use a marking wheel to evenly mark holes to stitch. Stitch the front & back together (use clips so the pieces don't move)
